



As well as the talks at The Beehive, Honiton u3a offers its members 36 different Interest Groups who meet each month. Groups range from Walking and Nature Appreciation, to Current Affairs and History, from Book Groups and Poetry Appreciation to Knitting and Crochet.

They have recently introduced a number of new groups including **French** and **Spanish**, **Art for Fun**, **Local History**, **Family History**, **Photography** and **Cribbage**. Honiton u3a hopes to introduce further new groups during the Autumn.


HONITON HILL RALLY 2024

Congratulations to the organisers.














EXI4 AREA MAP HONITON TOWN MAP

Great British Railways on the horizon!

The early weeks of the new Government have seen our railways feature strongly in its plans. The King's Speech confirmed proposals to nationalise almost all passenger services and to create a new body, called Great British Railways, to take responsibility for tracks and signalling as well as services. This process will take several years, however, as the Government will only take over services when the present contracts with operators such as South Western Railway (SWR) expire.

To those of us who use the railways, in the end what matters is not who has legal ownership of the service but whether the trains run on time, are reliable and comfortable. Therefore, it is important to recognise that, despite their existing contract with the Government running out next year, SWR are still firmly looking ahead.

At a recent meeting, they announced that the company is developing a 15-year plan for the West of England Line. The key elements of this plan are to improve performance and the reliability of services, to increase capacity on the line by introducing new services, especially between Honiton and Exeter, and to replace the rolling stock.

These are, of course, long-term goals, with the increased service dependent on the

track improvements west of Honiton that we continue to campaign hard for. Whoever runs the railway will also need shortly to decide when the very necessary updating of the signalling systems in the Salisbury and Exeter areas are carried out, which will replace older systems that increasingly have begun to break down.

At present, several options for rolling stock are being considered. The first involves battery electric trains, which could be modified versions of existing units or new stock. As an alternative, "cleaner" diesels trains could be introduced, although this would not of itself help move towards net zero.

As a stopgap, the existing trains could have their life extended beyond the early 2030s, in the hope that better alternatives, including more efficient batteries and fastcharging technology will become available. Further full electrification of lines in the South West seems a distant prospect.

To passengers using the service every day, talk of 15-year plans and nationalisation bills may seem to be of only academic interest. All they want is a regular, efficient service, at a reasonable cost, that is not delayed or cancelled. Working closely with the rail industry, I know that everyone concerned is doing everything they can to make sure this happens, now and in the future.

ALLHALLOWS MUSEUM, HONITON.

The Museum was opened in November 1946, and with a variety of volunteers guiding the development of the displays, it remains today in the safe hands of a group of enthusiastic volunteers. Originally the building was the chapel to Allhallows School which once occupied the site.

As a consequence there are many interesting and historic paintings on the arched ceilings of the museum. The foundation of the museum displays came from the private collection of Mr John Murch.

By 1965 the records show that the museum welcomed 5,000 visitors during the year. In the same year bones of various exotic animals were found during the excavations for the Honiton bypass. These important and exciting finds include hippo and elephant bones, some of which have ended up in Exeter Museum.

In the early 1980's as a result of the inspired decision to expand the collections and displays of local lace, visitor numbers rose dramatically. Then followed The Annual Honiton Lace Day, which brought even more visitors from far and wide. Between 1979 and 1992 the lace collection rose from 25 pieces to 208 pieces,

Now, Allhallows Museum is the home to many local artefacts, including the most comprehensive collection of Honiton lace in the world!

Allhallows Museum is open from Easter to October from Monday to Saturday of every week, and is run entirely by volunteers.

Allhallows Museum, Honiton is an accredited museum and a registered charity (306645) run entirely by volunteers.

Now we need to replace the 121 year old lead flat roof which covers the Gallery because it leaks when it rains, is beyond repair and no longer fit for purpose.

The basic day to day running costs of the museum are £55.70 per day, 365 days a year.

LUPPITT HARBOUR

With the summer holidays now over, many may be happy to say farewell to the 2024 season of caravans, tents and general ubiquity of tourists. But whilst they are buying their ice creams, hiking up the local produce prices, and blocking you in a traffic jam on the morning of that important meeting, do any of you know how to single them out?

In 1977 a letter appeared in the former local rag, "The Pulman's Weekly News", titled 'How to spot a grockle'. The letter described them 'as creatures found usually wandering around in groups' who 'swarm down to the beach in droves...when the sun is out' and are 'easy to recognise in various shades of red and brown' whose 'diet is basically very simple – chips'. However, if the reader still had trouble spotting examples of 'grockles' the author went on to describe how they always ask 'very funny questions' such as "What do you put in those crab sandwiches", "Is your cat real" and "Look at all those mackerel swimming in fresh water"!

Those stranded on the pre Honiton bypass days were easy to recognise as 'grockles' however, some clever local entrepreneurs, for 'a couple of bob', would direct these stranded motorists, via secret shortcuts, through the back lanes to the open highway. Yet it was, and still is to some, also customary to send these 'out of towners' on 'the scenic route' shall we say: by



directing those, who pull up with their window down asking "Excuse me, where is...?", the wrong way, or at least give them points to look out for, on the dictated route, that don't actually exist until they have gone mad, thrown the sat-nav from the window and are hopelessly lost! One such location, perhaps the favourite of places, Honitonians seem to like sending these forlorn creatures to must-be 'Luppitt Harbour' and you might even find one of these naive 'wound down window' travellers actually asking of its whereabouts.



The origins of this local 'red herring' are not really known. However, in 1977 a Mr Bowditch put forward a fishy story that he had been told by his father. It was said the village 'simpleton' of Luppit set some mole traps on Luppit Common and, during the night, some prankster set one of the traps off by sticking a 'bloater' in it. When, the following morning, the lad found he had caught a fish 600 feet above sea level in the middle of a field, it apparently never occurred to him that someone was 'having him on' and the story went round the village 'faster than gossip' and hence the area, near where the boy had set the traps, got the infamous local nickname.

Whether or not this actual account was the origin of this watery tourist attraction perhaps this retelling will save any future holiday makers the embarrassment of being sent on a fishy day trip to 'Luppitt Harbour' the next time a local suggests it to them!

Many editions of the former newspaper Pulman's Weekly can be viewed in Honiton Museum, which is also unfortunately needing to raise some funds to repair lead work to the roof so please drop by and support this fascinating local history spot.




